

The show will start promptly at 8 am each day.

Gypsy horses will abide by the GVHS Rule Set. Drum horses will abide by the IDHA Rule Set. Entries must be entered online at horseshowing.com by **May 17, 2024**

Horses will not be entered in classes until all requirements have been met. Entries must include:

- ✓ Completed and signed entry and release forms (STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY, GVHS Code of Conduct)
- ✓ Copy of registration papers for each horse (front and back)
- ✓ Copy of Coggins/Health certificates for out of state horses
- ✓ Copy of Amateur Cards for all entries in GVHS classes.

72 Performance Championship /Reserve custom made plaques!!! In addition to our existing Championships for; Gypsy Western Pleasure, Gypsy English Pleasure, Gypsy Trail in Hand, Gypsy Trail Under Saddle W/J and Gypsy Trail Under Saddle W/J/L, Gypsy Freestyle, Gypsy Pleasure Driving, and Gypsy Ranch Rail W/J and Gypsy Ranch Rail W/J/L divisions we have added in brand New Championship/Reserve awards for our shows going forward; Gypsy Ranch Riding W/J and Gypsy Ranch Riding W/J/L, Gypsy Western Dressage Suitability and Gypsy English Dressage Suitability, Gypsy Hunter Under Saddle W/T and Gypsy Hunter Under Saddle W/T/C, Gypsy Jumping (all), and Gypsy Walk/Whoa. Championship /Reserve awards are calculated. Dressage championships will include the in-hand classes. Championship /Reserve awards will be awarded for each judge (with the exception of Walk/Whoa, which is a combined total for both judges). Performance Champion and Reserve Championship placings are calculated.

8 High Points!!! In addition to our regular Youth High Point Awards and Overall Amateur/AOE High Point Waterford Bowl we will now be awarding plaques for High Point; AOE W/T, AOE W/T/C, Amateur W/T, Amateur W/T/C, and Open (New!!!). High Point awards will be based on the accumulation of points per division. Overall High Point Amateur/AOE is based on the total number of points accumulated in both divisions. One High Point will be awarded per each division stated above.

26 custom Neck sashes and 20 more custom plaques to win!!! In addition to our Supreme sashes, neck sashes will be awarded for ALL the Champion Halter placings. Plaques will be awarded for all the Reserve Halter placings. All above awards are awarded under BOTH judges.

There are NO fees for Championship classes at our shows!!!

Championship/High Point awards are based on the 2024 GVHS Points System.

Notes to Exhibitors:

Pre-registration: Show management is asking that you be courteous of all exhibitors. In order to have the show run as smoothly as possible, we are asking you to please register two (2) weeks in advance of the show. If we find we need more room, the show manager can request additional space two (2) weeks before the show. So, we need to have a very close count at that time.

Adds/Scratches: Show management requests that all adds and scratches be in the show software (horseshowing.com). If you have issues with the software, please have any adds or scratches in the office no later than 6:00 pm each prior evening. This helps to prevent early-morning chaos in the office and allows the show to start promptly at 8:00 am each morning.

Office Hours: The show office will open at 7:00 am each morning and will remain open for 30 minutes after the last class of the day.

Camping Permits: No one may plug into RV electricity without purchasing a permit at the show office. Show management will check the RV parking area every morning in order to monitor that permits are visible.

After Hours: Please call 614-519-2912 (Lee Brackman) for assistance with camping or stalling issues after office hours. We will endeavor to resolve any issues as quickly as possible.

Exhibitors and Spectators: No alcoholic beverages are permitted. Intoxicated behavior by exhibitors or spectators on the showgrounds is strictly prohibited and the person or people exhibiting this behavior will be expelled from the showgrounds. Abusive behavior towards staff members or fellow exhibitors will be subject to removal from the show grounds. No refunds will be issued to those removed. Due to animal welfare and unsportsmanlike conduct issues industry wide, effective 2024 show season, exhibitors and spectators will both be asked to sign The GVHS Code of Conduct form, which must be signed prior to back numbers being distributed. Please refer to the Animal Welfare and Unsportsmanlike Conduct Process and Procedures as well as the Penalty and Fines Lists for both posted on the GVHS site for further information. The staff will be supplied with the official GVHS Warning Cards/Report of GVHS Rule Violation Complaint Forms to initiate the formal procedures in the event that welfare/conduct issues occur.

Dogs: All dogs in the horse area MUST be on a leash OR THEY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS.

Warning: Under the Ohio Equine Activity Liability Act, an equine professional is not liable of injury to or the death of a participant in an equine activity resulting from an inherent risk of the equine activity.

Online Entries: Online entries are submitted at horseshowing.com. You will need to create a free account. Please direct technology questions related to your entries to attn: Lee at mustachedhorseguild@gmail.com. To

not incur additional fees please pay show fees via PayPal Friends and Family(mustachedhorseguild@gmail.com), not the software which charges additional fees.

Barn Rules: **Do NOT staple to the stalls.** Any damage done to the stall walls will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. **Do NOT tie horses to stall bars.** Any damage done to the stall hardware will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Action will be taken with the registry(ies) in the event of failure to compensate the facility for any damage incurred.

Class Scribe Fees: Due to the number of classes that will be scored with forms this year due to new 2024 GVHS rules, we will be hiring additional staff (scribes) to assist the judges. Scribes will ensure the judges can fully focus on you and your horse's performance. Due to the need for additional staff for these classes, there will be a \$2 additional scribe service charge **per class** (\$1 per scribe). The following Open/Amateur/Youth Classes will be charged with the additional fee; Horsemanship, Equitation, Showmanship, Ranch Riding, Trail (In Hand and Under Saddle), and Freestyle.

We will be enforcing the 2-minute gate rule. Please be courteous of all exhibitors. Have your horses ready and at the gate when your class is called. If you know you need extra time for a tack change (5 minutes), fill out the Tack Hold Form and give it to the Gate Steward at the start of the division.

We will be enforcing the 2-minute gate rule.

Breaks are posted in the showbill for your convenience. Additional breaks may be added at the discretion of show management.


All dogs must be on a leash at all times and current on Ohio State Health Department requirements. This is a facility rule. No drugs or alcoholic beverages permitted.

Remember, if you travel across the Ohio state line, you will need to have a negative Coggins certificate and a Veterinary health certificate with you for each horse/pony you have onboard. The Ohio Department of Veterinary Health may require additional testing (such as temperature readings) during active disease outbreaks. Paperwork must be available upon request of the show manager.

The GVHS Code of Conduct

The Gypsy Vanner Horse Society (GVHS) members and non-members who have chosen to participate in GVHS sanctioned shows and events, including riders, coaches, officials, and volunteers must conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner, and are responsible for their actions in competitions, going to and from competitions, and while at areas hosting competitions. In all equestrian sports the well-being of the horse shall be above the demands of trainers, riders, owners, organizers, sponsors, or officials. All riding and training methods must demonstrate respect for the horse as a living entity and may not include any techniques considered to be abusive or overtaxing of the horse's ability or fitness. Members and nonmembers who have chosen to participate are responsible for adherence to the GVHS competition rules and procedures.

- Be respectful of officials, even if you do not agree with them.
- Encourage riders and show your appreciation for their efforts.
- Do not openly ridicule and criticize participants and/or their horses.
- Do not encourage unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Do not use inappropriate language to either riders, officials, or other spectators.
- Do not use or threaten physical violence to anyone.
- Abide by rules and reasonable directions given by show officials.
- You will be cautioned, reported and/or asked to leave any GVHS and/or affiliated show premises without reimbursement of shows fees paid if you violate any terms of this Code of Conduct.
- Making adverse comments directly to the media, either in written or verbal form, about the GVHS, GVHS sanctioned events and its affiliates may result in disqualification from an event, loss of points earned at the event and possibly prevent participation at future GVHS sanctioned events at the discretion of the GVHS Board.

NOTE: Anyone may respectfully approach the steward or show management to report violation(s) to the GVHS Code of Conduct. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification from an event, loss of points earned at the event and possibly prevent participation at future GVHS sanctioned events at the discretion of show management, show steward and/or GVHS Board. The GVHS reserves the right to refuse admission and/or participation of GVHS sanctioned events or functions to anyone.

The GVHS Code of Conduct for Spectators GVHS sanctioned Shows welcome spectators; your support encourages and supports the participants. Your actions can have a positive or negative effect on the show. Therefore:

- Be respectful of officials, even if you do not agree with them.
- Encourage riders and show your appreciation for their efforts.
- Do not openly ridicule and criticize participants and/or their horses.
- Do not encourage unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Do not use inappropriate language to either riders, officials, or other spectators.
- Do not use or threaten physical violence to anyone.
- Abide by rules and reasonable directions given by show officials.
- You will be cautioned, reported and/or asked to leave any GVHS and/or affiliate show premises if you violate any terms of this Code of Conduct for Spectators.
